## PE & Sports Funding: 2015-2016

### **Purpose of funding:**

To improve the PE and sport provision within school to benefit all pupils.

### **Impact of Sports Premium Funding:**

- The introduction of Change 4 Life Clubs to support and engage our least active children.
- Created a sustainable PE program by purchasing new PE equipment.
- Increased opportunities for pupils to participate in sporting competitions through the School Games.
- Increased proportions of pupils participating in after school sports clubs and holiday clubs.
- Pupils accessing professional sports facilities and professional coaching to enable participation in outdoor adventure sports.
- Development of a new sports curriculum to include sports not usually associated with the National Curriculum.
- Supported travel to competitive sporting events to enable a greater proportion of pupils to take part.
- Created a parent's community sport training program.
- Achieved GOLD School's Game Mark
- Pupils accessed sporting opportunities in the local community: eg: Manchester FA.
