PE & Sports Funding: 2016-2017

Purpose of funding:

To improve the PE and sport provision within school to benefit all pupils.

Impact of Sports Premium Funding:

- Engagement of all pupils in physical activity and in promoting healthy lifestyles. Created a sustainable PE program by purchasing new PE or Gym equipment.
- Increase pupil participation in competitive sports. Increased proportions of pupils participating in after school sports clubs.
- Broader range of sports and activities offered to pupils. Development of a new sports curriculum to include sports not usually associated with the National Curriculum.
- Increase confidence, Knowledge and skills of PE leader to deliver training to all staff. Created a parent's community sport training program.
- Raise the profile of PE across the school and community Pupils accessed sporting opportunities in the local community: eg: Manchester FA.
- Maintain Gold In School games award.
